\***Harbor Light Center** In-patient treatment and rehab for substance abusers. Educational and spiritual programs available, GED classes and continuing support for clients who complete the 60 day program.

\***Eagle Creek Corps/Community Center** Worship and Christian Education programs for all ages. Latchkey, summer day camp, character building programs for young people and a full complement of church activities available for the family.

\***Booth Manor** A senior living community for low to moderate income offers assisted housing payments for qualifying residents. Recreational, educational and worship activities are offered with transportation to area stores provided weekly.

\***Fountain Square Corps/Community Center** A multiplicity of services are available to all age groups at this south-side facility. Hot meals served at noon daily to all who come to the facility. Educational, fellowship, and worship programs are scheduled for children through adults; character building programs are offered to boys and girls; after school tutoring classes and computer lab available during the week.

\***Center for Older Adult Ministries/Fountain Square** Educational, musical, physical fitness, worship, craft and fellowship activities are offered daily to seniors, and a healthy hot lunch is served each week day.

\***Social Service Center** The city's most comprehensive program for abused women offers services committed to improving quality of life and the level of self-sufficiency of each client. A shelter for homeless women, Family Life Development classes, Literacy Plus (reading, writing & GED), Computer Skills, Medical, WIC, Parenting Class, Domestic Abuse Prevention & Awareness Class, Praise & Worship and a mental health program.

\***Indiana Older Adult Ministries** Summer residential camp, Spring and Christmas dinners held for seniors from around the state. Resources and program ideas are available through this office.

\***Gift of Warmth & Community Care Program** Visits are made to area nursing homes, health care facilities and the Veteran's Administration hospital. In addition, area shut-ins receive gifts and a visit from The Salvation Army volunteers during the Christmas season.

\***Adult Rehabilitation Center** The ARC provides long-range, intensive in-resident care for men recovering from alcohol and substance abuse. Five levels for growth in all areas of life must be completed to graduate from this program. Responsibility, work ethics, changing old behaviors and patterns, and learning new ways of living are emphasized.

\***Center City Ministries** Worship, Education, Spiritual Counseling and Fellowship opportunities provided for those in the downtown area.

\***Johnson County** Worship and Christian Education programs for all ages. Character building programs for young people, along with Sunday Worship Services.
